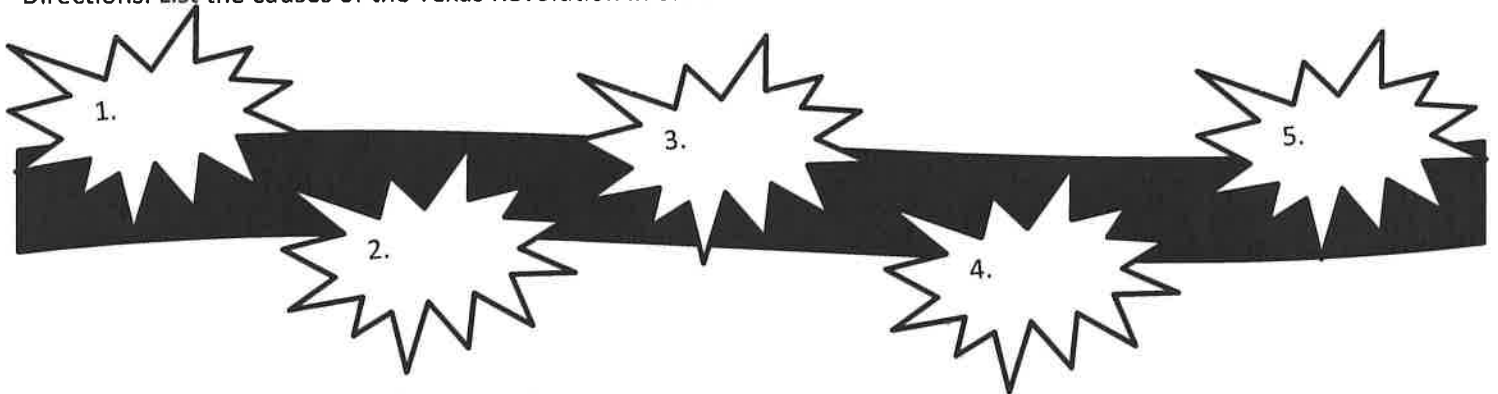

B. Restricted US trade, slaves & immigration.

C. Mexico interpreted my letter as encouragement for Texans to separate from Texas.

D. Edwards brothers started their own country because settlers were on the land they had been promised. They ran away when Mexico sent soldiers.

E. Sent word to Santa Anna that Anglos outnumbered Tejanos 10:1 in Texas.

1. "Soldiers....Our Comrades have been shamefully sacrificed at Anahuac, Goliad and Bexar, and you are the ones destined to punish their murderers." (Doc A)

2. "Santa Anna has recently arrived here at the Alamo. We haven't suffered any casualties yet, but it is clear that we will need many reinforcements. I will send Seguin with my letter asking for help"....

3. "Here is our contract proving this land in East Texas belongs to us. You need to leave."

4. "Please don't make me sacrifice the lives of General Fannin and his troops here at Goliad. They have already surrendered."

5. "I recommend more European/Mexican immigration to Texas and no more trading with the US."

6. "I borrowed ideas from the US Declaration of Independence when authoring the TX Declaration of Independence."

D. Almost all the Texans led by William B. Travis were killed in this battle. Santa Anna also lost many of his skilled soldiers. It became a famous rally cry of the Battle of San Jacinto.

F. Mexicans lose this 18 minute battle. TX wins Independence. Santa Anna captured and forced to sign the Treaties of Velasco peace treaties.
